Basic Rules for Success

- ❖ **Respect** is the number one rule for success. Students will show respect at all times for all staff members, each other, school property, and themselves.
- ❖ Students are to have a **signed pass** any time they leave a classroom to go anywhere (even if the student is called by the Main Office).
- ❖ Students are to **avoid going to their lockers** during the day with the exception of the pre-determined locker periods (before school, before lunch period, end of the day) or with a signed pass.
- ❖ Students are **not to use electronics in the building**. The policy is clear: if we see it or hear it, it will be taken.
 - **all confiscated electronics will be turned in to the main office
 - **1st offense:** a parent must come in to retrieve the electronic device and a DT will be given
 - **2nd offense:** a parent must come in to retrieve the electronic device and an in-house or an extended DT will be given
 - **3rd offense :** A meeting with the parent and an administrator is required before the device will be returned and the student will receive both an in-house and an extended DT
- ❖ Students are expected to be on time for school and for all classes every day. Students should be in their first period class by 8:05 - late students are to report to the office before going to their first period class. Students who are late to classes after first period will receive disciplinary consequences from the teacher.
- ❖ Students are to adhere to the dress code at all times. Those in violation of the dress code will be subject to disciplinary consequences. Additionally, excessively ripped jeans, hats, and slides are prohibited. Pants must remain pulled up to the waist at all times.
